REFRESHMENTS	Hot and cold food and drinks: will be available to purchase in the club house prior to assembly and again at lunch time. Please order lunch food in the club house before morning shooting commences.						
TENTS &	<b>Tents</b> are permitted for this event and must be sited in the marked areas.						
PARKING	All cars must be parked in the designated car park; no cars allowed on the competition field.						
WALKWAYS & SMOKING	<ul> <li>Walkways: There are no designated walkways at this event that need to be kept clear. However, if you are asked to move equipment for access, please comply with the request promptly.</li> <li>Smoking, including e-cigarettes, is permitted on the field well behind the tent area and to the side of the club house facing the car park. Please do not leave cigarette ends and rubbish on the field.</li> </ul>						
PHOTOGRAPHY	Any persons, whether archers or visitors, intending to take photographs, either still or video, are requested to register their intention with the Tournament Organiser. Entrants bringing visitors to the tournament are asked to make them aware of this requirement.						
RULES	This is a <b>Record Status</b> event and <b>Archery GB Rules of Shooting will apply</b> . (http://www.archerygb.org/support/operations/rules/index.php). Only clothing in compliance with Rule 307 will be permitted (in particular, <b>blue denim</b> , <b>olive drab and camouflage patterned clothing</b> , <b>as well as wording</b> <b>and badges other than archer's names</b> , <b>sponsor's names and logos</b> , <b>clothing manufacturer's trademarks and</b> <b>archery organisation's names and logos are not permitted</b> ). All entrants must be members of Archery GB or World Archery and must sign the entry form to confirm that they have received instruction in clout shooting prior to the event. Archers competing at Record Status tournaments will be liable for drugs testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Any refusal will be treated as a positive result. A parent						
	or legal guardian of each archer under 18 must sign the form to signify consent to the junior being tested if approached. All Juniors must be accompanied by their parent or guardian. The Tournament Organisers have the right to exclude any person from the field for unreasonable behaviour. The Judge in Charge is responsible for the safe conduct of the shoot at all times. The Judge's decision is final and must be obeyed.						
ELIGIBILITY	This competition is open to individuals affiliated to Archery GB or a World Archery member association. Please bring proof of membership (e.g. Archery GB Card).
