(http://www.archerygb.org/documents_governance.php?folderid=2708&includeref=doclist1198)  Only clothing in compliance with Rule 307 will be permitted (in particular, blue denim, olive drab and camouflage patterned clothing as well as wording and badges other than archer's names, sponsor's names and logos, clothing manufacturer's trademarks and archery organisation's names and logos are not permitted).  Shooting sequence and timing of ends will follow archery GB Rules 304(b) and 304(f) Method 2.  The Tournament Organisers have the right to exclude any persons from the field for unreasonable behaviour.  The Chairman of Judges is responsible for the safe conduct of the shoot at all times, the judge's decision is final and must be obeyed.
