Rounds	<p>Albion, Windsor, Short Windsor, Junior Windsor & Short Junior Windsor: Medals to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd places as per the round table over the page shooting Recurve, Barebow, Compound or Longbow. There will be a bonus 25 points for any archer competing in medieval dress. We hope to also have some fun medieval shooting at the end of the event for longbow, barebow and recurve archers.</p>
Refreshments & Food	<p>Hot and cold refreshments are provided during the shoot as well as pulled pork sandwiches (vegetarian option will be available). We are unfortunately unable to cater for all dietary requirements, but will do our best! Please indicate on the entry form if you require this option.</p>
Eligibility & V.I.P	<p>Entry forms received after the closing date may still compete, but will not be eligible for trophies, unless they are a replacement for an archer no longer able to attend. Refunds will not be available after the closing date and are at the discretion of the Tournament Organisers otherwise. This competition is open to individuals affiliated to Archery GB or a World Archery member association. Please bring proof of membership. Rules	<p>Archery GB Rules of Shooting will apply. Only clothing in compliance with Rule 307 or medieval attire will be permitted (this prohibits in particular, blue denim, olive drab and camouflage patterned clothing as well as wording and badges other than archer's names, sponsor's names and logos, clothing manufacturer's trademarks and archery organisation's names and logos are not permitted). The tournament organisers have the right to exclude any persons from the field for unreasonable behaviour. The Chairman of Judges is responsible for the safe conduct of the shoot at all times, the judge's decision is final and must be obeyed. All archers may be asked to complete a drugs test and must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents and guardians must authorise drugs testing of junior archers by signing entry form.</p>
Data Protection	<p>When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.</p>
Photography	<p>Any person, whether archers or visitors, intending to take photographs, either still or video, are requested to register their intention with the Tournament Organiser. Entrants bringing visitors to the tournament are asked to make them aware of this requirement.</p>
Walkways & Smoking	<p>There are no designated walkways at this event that need to be kept clear; however, if you are asked to move equipment for access, please comply with the request promptly. Smoking, including e-cigarettes and vaping, is permitted on the field but well behind the tent area and to the side of the club house facing the car park. Real archers don't leave cigarette ends and rubbish on the field as it is prohibited.</p>
Tents & Parking	<p>Tents are permitted for this event and must be sited in the marked areas. All cars must be parked in the designated car park, no cars allowed on the competition field.</p>
