Rules	Archery GB Rules of Shooting will apply. <b>Only clothing in compliance with Rule 307</b> will be permitted (this prohibits in particular, blue denim, olive drab and camouflage patterned clothing as well as wording and badges other than archer's names, sponsor's names and logos, clothing manufacturer's trademarks and archery organisation's names and logos are not permitted). The tournament organisers have the right to exclude any persons from the field for unreasonable behaviour. The Chairman of Judges is responsible for the safe conduct of the shoot at all times, the judge's decision is final and must be obeyed.  All archers may be asked to complete a drugs test and must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents and guardians must authorise drugs testing of junior archers by signing entry form.
