ROUNDS	Wand Shoot: 6 dozen arrows (sighters, 3 dozen, lunch break, 3 dozen) or as many as conditions allow. Ladies, Gents – Recurve / Barebow / Longbow - choose either 140y or 100y Juniors (<18) – Recurve / Barebow / Longbow - 60y Archers who have never shot Clout are advised to shoot max 100y. Juniors may choose to shoot 140y/100y but will then be awarded as Adults. All Wands are approx 6' tall x 6" wide, with a tie-breaker Oblong painted on the ground behind each Wand.
AWARDS	Trophies/Medals for 1st, 2nd & 3rd places for Ladies, Gents, Juniors for: Recurve, Barebow, Longbow Fun prizes: First/Best Shield + Shoot the Hat + Instant Prizes + Most Oblongs + Volley, etc.
FEE	Fee: £9 per archer – includes free tea/coffee, plus soup and a roll and a mince pie at the lunch break

CLOSING DATE, LATE ENTRIES	CLOSING DATE: Saturday 25 th November 2023 (or when the shoot is full). No refunds after the Closing Date unless the shoot is cancelled. Late entries: will be subject to space and Tournament Organiser's discretion.

TARGET LIST, RESULTS	Target List will be emailed to addresses provided a few days before the shoot. Results will be posted on SAC website and emailed to addresses provided as soon as possible after the shoot.
REFRESHMENTS	Food & drinks free tea/coffee on arrival, plus free soup & a roll & a mince pie at lunch break, in the pavilion.
TENTS & PARKING	Tents are permitted for this event and must be sited in the marked areas only. All cars must be parked in the car park at the top beyond the buildings; no cars will be allowed on the field. Disabled parking: Please note on the entry form if you require a disabled parking space by the pavilion.
SMOKING	Smoking , including e-cigarettes, is not permitted anywhere on the fields, only by the bicycle shed opposite the buildings or in the car park. Please do not leave cigarette ends and rubbish on the field.
PHOTOGRAPHY	Any persons, whether archers or visitors, intending to take photographs, either still or video, are required to register their intention with the Tournament Organiser. Entrants bringing visitors to the tournament are asked to make them aware of this requirement.
DRESS CODE	Dress code: Rule 307 does not apply. Please dress sensibly for weather conditions. Christmas Fancy Dress is encouraged but will not be judged.
RULES	All entrants must be members of Archery GB or World Archery – Please bring proof of membership (e.g. Archery GB Card). The Tournament Organisers have the right to exclude any person from the field for unreasonable behaviour. The Field Captain is responsible for the safe conduct of the shoot at all times. The Field Captain's decision is final.
